



Mr. Hugh K. Ferry

April 3, 1931 - March 16, 2023

Hugh K. Ferry, 91, of Main Dalton Road in Windsor, passed away at his home on Thursday, March 16, 2023. Born on April 3, 1931 in Windsor, MA on his family's farm where he both lived and worked all his life, he was the son of the late Amos and Helen Kelso Ferry.

Hugh was married to the love of his life, the former Peggy Howes, for 67 years until her passing in 2018.

For the majority of his career, Hugh was employed by Crane and Company. It was there he dedicated 35 years of service, most of the time as a truck driver. He also worked in the construction industry on the Mass Pike.

He was a member of Windsor's Bicentennial Committee, and, in 1971, was able to travel with them to the White House to be congratulated by Richard Nixon. Hugh was also a member of the snowmobile club, The Windsor Snow Gremlins.

Hugh was involved with the 4-H for 20 years, and enjoyed playing in the Pitch league at Cummington's Rod and Gun Club. He was a part of the Cummington Fair for over 70 years, where he worked in various different positions. Additionally, he volunteered for the Town of Windsor's Fire Department for over 60 years, many of those spent as their chief.

Hugh is survived by his daughter, Helen Ferry of Colorado, and his son Eric Ferry and his wife Christine, of Windsor. He leaves behind two grandsons, Gregory and Joshua Ferry of Windsor, as well as many nieces, nephews, great nieces, and great nephews. Hugh was also blessed with his neighbor Max, who made and shared dinner with him almost every night.

Hugh was predeceased by his parents, as well as his beloved wife, Peggy Ferry.
