Mr. James D. DePatie, 53, of 70 John St., Pittsfield, passed away early Tuesday morning, August 5, 2014 at Baystate Medical Center after a short illness. Born in Greenwich, CT on November 21, 1960 the son of David L. DePatie and the late Marie F. McGrath DePatie, he was a 1978 graduate of Our Lady of the Rosary Catholic School in Monroe, CT.
