Mr. James P. Marcil, of Pittsfield, passed away on Wednesday, April 1, 2026, just months after celebrating his 62nd birthday. Born in Adams, MA, on January 27, 1964, he was the son of the late Paul Marcil and Nancy Perry Denley. Jim attended Lee High school and obtained his GED in 1984 and later earned his PHD Psychology in Rochville University.

For the majority of his career, Jim worked as a therapist in Brattleboro Retreat House and Community House in Brattleboro VT in the 90's. He was a substance abuse officer in Gibson Recovery Center in Sikeston MO in 2006 after which he transitioned his career as a loan officer in former Oak n Spruce Resort in Lee MA for four years before he retired.
