



Mr. Jerry Willis

May 11, 1949 - October 23, 2017

Jerry Willis, 68, of Pittsfield, passed away peacefully surrounded by family in Port Charlotte, Florida on Monday, Oct. 23, after a long struggle with cancer. Jerry Willis was born in Chicago, Illinois on May 11, 1949 to Julia Street and Warnell Willis(pre-deceased). He was raised by his great Uncle Otha P. Street and his wife Apenda Street(pre-deceased) from the age of 9 months while living in Roanoke, Virginia. The family moved to Pittsfield when he was 12 years old. He attended the former South Junior High, then went on to graduate from Pittsfield High School in 1969. During his youth, he was a member of Pittsfield Cavaliers drum and bugle corps as a drummer from 1965-1967. Jerry enlisted in the US Army on October 30, 1969, and completed his basic training at Fort Dix, New Jersey. He served in Vietnam from July 2, 1970 to April 22, 1971 as an aircraft electrician. He received an Honorable discharge in April 1972. He was a member of the Second Congregational Church and the Berkshire County branch of the NAACP. On December 23, 1972, he married Marlena Lee of Hancock, MA and had two children Santha and Shane. He worked for H.V. Rabouin Inc. for 41 years as a transporter and retired in 2015. For all his years of dedication to safety on the highways, Jerry was inducted into the One Million Mile Club sponsored by Caterpillar Inc.

In his spare time, he liked to tinker on anything electrical and mechanical; especially automobiles. He was known as a “jack of all trades” and was lovingly referred to as “MacGyver” by those closest to him. Jerry enjoyed,

fishing, golfing, biking and bowling. He also enjoyed music; especially listening to Jazz, watching comedy and movies of all genres.

Jerry leaves behind his wife, Marlena Willis of Pittsfield, MA, daughter Santha Willis, and son Shane Willis and his wife Shana Pierce-Willis, two grandsons Averil and Shaney Willis- all of Port Charlotte, Florida. He also leaves sisters Arnetta Sandifer (John), Apenda Walker(Frank)-both of Pittsfield; Bonnie Lewis of Fort Wayne, Indiana; Renee Willis of Elkhart, Indiana; and Patricia Willis of Chicago, Illinois. Brothers Michael Jones, Nickolas Jones, and Kenneth Jones- all of Pittsfield; Michael Willis, Harold Willis and Hugh Willis (Verlinda) Willis of Chicago, Illinois; Billy Willis (Betty) of Cassopolis, Michigan, and Warnell Willis, Jr. of Colorado. He was pre-deceased by his two brothers Bernie Street and George Jones of Pittsfield, a brother-in-law, Thomas Lewis of Fort Wayne, Indiana and a nephew, Adam Sandifer.
