John Francis Carpenter, of Hinsdale, passed away at home on November 26, 2021, just one day after celebrating his 70th birthday. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on November 25, 1951, the son of the late James Carpenter and Anita Shartrand (Leo), he grew up in Pittsfield, Lee, and Becket.

John enlisted in the United States Army from 1970 until 1972, where he served in the Vietnam War before starting his career with Crane and Company. He retired from Crane and Company after 40 years of service.
