Mr. John R. Doyle, 83, of 58 Ingalls Rd., Cheshire, passed away on May 25, 2014 at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Pittsfield on December 9, 1930 the son of Richard M. and Margorie Sigsworth Doyle he was a graduate of Pittsfield High School.

Mr. Doyle was a US Air Force Veteran, serving during Korea. He retired from the Air Force with 21 years of service.

After retirement from the Air Force, Mr. Doyle went to work for the United States Postal Service as a Mail Clerk. He retired from the Post Office with 20 years of service.
