Mr. John H. Fiske, of Windsor, passed away on Thursday, November 17, 2022, with his daughter by his side, just one month after his 75th birthday. Born in Greenfield, MA on October 8, 1947, the son of the late Murray and Marion Settright Fiske, he graduated from Greenfield Vocational High School. Shortly after, John enlisted in the Army National Guard, where he proudly served his country for 6 years.

In his earlier career, John worked as an installer for Time Warner Cable. After 25 years of service, John changed careers becoming a truck driver, which he was so proud to say "I am a professional truck driver:" until his retirement.

Among many things, he enjoyed being outdoors, farming especially. John loved riding horses, and even participated in gymkhanas for many years! While he always appreciated watching a good game of professional football, nothing brought a bigger smile to his face than cheering on his grandsons, Taylor and Jordan, at their own sporting events. Everyone who knew him, knew how proud he was of them and everything they did.

John was extremely active in his community. In 1976, he became a member of the Hinsdale Volunteer Fire Department and Muster Team, where he served until 1978. Following his time in Hinsdale, he volunteered on the Windsor Fire Department for over 20 years.

In 1993, John became a Mason at the Unity Lodge, to which he enhanced honors, becoming a Master of Unity of Lodge in 2009 and, furthermore, Master of Globe Unity Lodge the following year. Additionally, John was proud of being a Shriner at Melha, and very active in many groups and activities.

John is survived by his beloved wife of 52 years, the former Louisa Zahn, whom he married February 19, 1970. In addition to his grandsons, he leaves his daughter Louisa Fiske, his son Murray Fiske (Rebecca) and 4 grandchildren, Haileigh, Nikolas, Ryan and Koleyne.

John was a kind man with a giving heart, always there to help anybody in need. While he will be sorely missed, his memory will live on by all of those who were blessed to have known him.

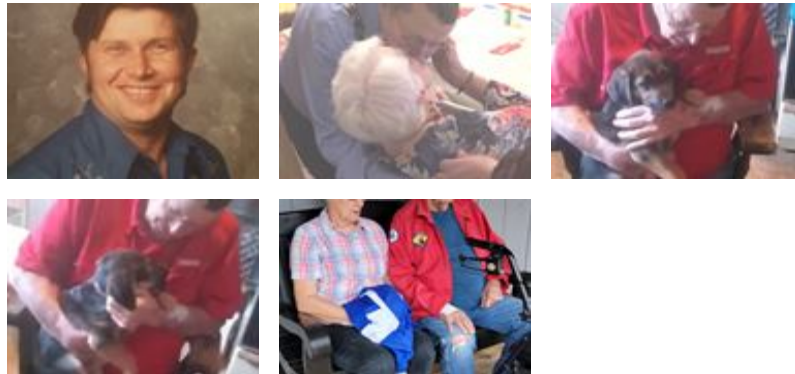
