Mr. John A. Kilfeather, 66, of 15 Lacona St., Lanesborough died Wednesday, May 01, 2013 at home. Born in Pittsfield on August 1, 1946 the son of John J. and Charlotte Warner Kilfeather, he attended St. Joseph High School. After High School, John enlisted in the US Marine Corps. and was a Vietnam Veteran. He received several service medals including the Purple Heart Medal.

Mr. Kilfeather worked for many years at Berkshire Medical Center as a Fireman in the Boiler Room. He had previously worked at the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Plant and also at the former Hillcrest Hospital in the Boiler Room.

He was a member of the American Legion Post 68, the VFW Post 448, the Marine Corps League, the Lions Club and was also a member of the Polish Falcons.

He was predeceased by his wife, the former Elizabeth J. Norton, whom he married on August 19, 1967 in St. Charles Church. She died on May 18, 1998.
