



## Mr. John R. Morrow, Jr.

April 2, 1937 - May 17, 2026

Mr. John R. Morrow, Jr., of Washington, MA, passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday, May 17, 2026, just weeks after celebrating his 89th birthday. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on April 2, 1937, son of the late John and Myrtle Crosier Morrow, he graduated from Pittsfield High School with the class of 1955.

Shortly after high school, John enlisted in the United States Army. It was there that he proudly served his country from 1955 until his honorable discharge in 1958.

For the majority of his career, John was employed by O'Connell Oil, where he worked as a gas delivery driver. It was from there that he retired after many years of dedicated service, and countless friendships made along the way.
