Mr. John G. Schultheis, 62, of Pittsfield, passed away unexpectedly at home on Saturday, January 14, 2017. Born in Pittsfield on August 15, 1954 the son of Gunther and Mary Hilliard Schultheis, he was a 1972 graduate of St. Joseph High School.

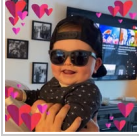
