John Tart, 41, of Pittsfield, MA, passed away at home on August 13, 2018 following a long illness. Born in Pittsfield on December 13, 1976 the son of the Mary Tart and the late Terrence Tart, he was a 1995 graduate of Taconic High School.

John worked as a telecommunicator for Canyon Ranch, retiring in 2004 following an injury that left him disabled.

There were driving back home to NY in my little green Honda Civic some time after midnight when Jack took the shortcut down Cloverdale Ave. He was going around that hairpin turn by the railroad tracks when he hit a patch of ice, went sliding and steered the car through the opening in the guardrails rather than crash into them. They landed straight on top of the railroad tracks and were stuck. They panicked, jumped out and tried to push the car off the tracks. When they realized it was fruitless they started yelling for help.

An anonymous young man came out in the middle of the night with his truck. He hitched up the car and pulled it right off the tracks. The kids were so shook up they didn't even get his name.
