



Mr. John "Jack" Wilkinson

Mr. John "Jack" R. Wilkinson, 63, of 236 Connecticut Ave. passed away suddenly Saturday evening, February 15, 2014, at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Pittsfield on January 8, 1951 the son of George and Ann Pigott Wilkinson, he was a 1969 graduate of Pittsfield High School.

Mr. Wilkinson was a mold maker for several local Plastic companies, including Cavallero Plastics. He was presently working for Agi-Amaray Mold and Tool. He was a US Army veteran and a communicant of St. Charles Church. Jack enjoyed flying radio controlled airplanes and was a member of the Berkshire RC Flying Club. He was also a member of the O'Laughlin's Sportsmen's Club.

His greatest joy was spending time with his family and his beloved dogs Mimi and Gidget.

Mr. Wilkinson leaves his wife, the former Tracy Woodstock, whom he married on May 24, 2003 at St. Charles Church.
