Mr. John Wojcik, 75, a proud Vietnam Veteran, of Pittsfield, passed away on Tuesday, July 15, 2025. Born in Adams, MA, on February 1, 1950, son of the late Henry and Caroline Wojcik, he attended Notre Dame school and graduated from Adams High with the class of 1967.
