Mr. Joseph S. Paglier, Jr., 61, of Pittsfield, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, September 16, 2020. 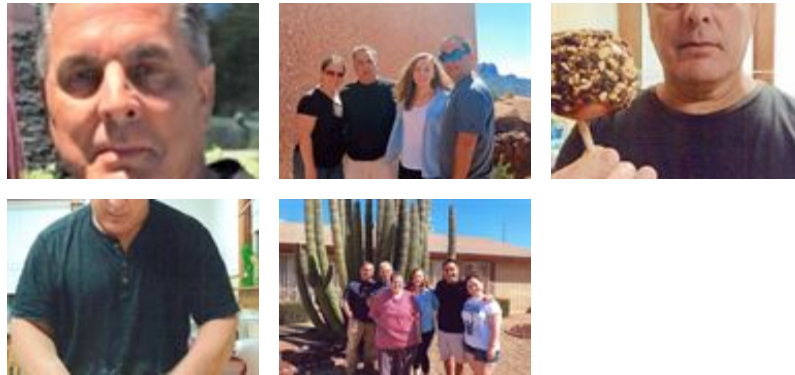
