Mrs. Judith "Judy" MacCartney, 82, of Pittsfield, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, June 3, 2024. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on January 24, 1942, the daughter of the late Leo and June Tart Henault, she graduated from Pittsfield High School with the class of 1959.

For much of her career, Judith was employed by Phillips Industrial Services, where she worked as a bookkeeper. It was there she dedicated 36 years of service until her retirement. She later worked as a bookkeeper for Bousquet.
