



## Mr. Leo N. Bradley

June 6, 1916 - March 17, 2012

Mr. Leo N. Bradley, 95, of 50 Oswald Ave. died March 17, 2012 at the Berkshire Medical Center.

Born in Loretto, PA on June 6, 1916 he was the son of Thomas A. and Bertha Lynch Bradley.

He was one of eleven brothers and sisters.

Mr. Bradley graduated from Cresson High School in Cresson, PA in the class of 1937.

He was employed at the General Electric Company as a transformer technician retiring in 1982 after many years of service.

He was a WW II US Air Force Veteran being honorably discharged on Feb. 8, 1946 as a rank of Corporal. He was the proud recipient of the American Theatre Ribbon, Good Conduct Medal and the WW II Victory Medal. While in the Air Force he was an airplane engine mechanic.

He was an avid raccoon hunter, enjoyed horse racing and loved spending time with his grandchildren.

His wife, the former Rita Martin Reeves died April 20, 1977.

He leaves a son Thomas T. Bradley (Sharon) of Pittsfield. His beloved granddaughters Danielle and Kelsey Bradley.

He also leaves behind a step-daughter Kathleen Coffey (Joseph) of Camarillo, CA. and a step son Paul Reeves (Marilyn) of Pittsfield, MA and three step grandchildren David Coffey, Darlene Williams and Michelle Rivers.

He is survived by two brothers Raymond Bradley of Gallitzin, PA and Frank Bradley of Cresson, Pennsylvania.
