Linda and George were married in 1969 and made their home in Pittsfield, MA, for over 50 years. There they raised their three beautiful children, Christopher, Brian, and Aimee. Linda and George celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary with their family in July 2019.

Linda found immense happiness in spending time with her family and friends and was always the consummate conversationalist. She was always upbeat and positive and found a way to be the life of any gathering or party. Her sense of humor and deep sense of caring was palpable for anyone who was around her; it was nearly impossible not to smile when around Linda.

In retirement, Linda and George embarked on countless adventures, exploring the world together, always seeking authentic experiences and connections. Together they created cherished memories in Pittsfield, Naples, and on many trips.
