RICHMOND, MA - Mrs. Lois H. Reynolds, 93, of Rossiter Road died suddenly on Monday, May 14 at Berkshire Medical Center.

Born in Pittsfield, MA on September 12, 1925 she was the daughter of Ernest L. and Ethel (Schilling) Henry. She lived her early years in the Flatbrook Section of Canaan, NY before moving to Richmond in 1938.

She was a 1941 graduate of Pittsfield High School and a 1944 graduate of The Henry W. Bishop 3rd Memorial School of Nursing in Pittsfield.

Early on in her nursing career she worked during the polio epidemic. Lois also worked for many years at the Well-Child Conference at the Richmond School, and cared for both her parents until their passing.

Lois had a true love for nature, walking and reading.

She was a member of the Richmond Congregational Church, the Kings Daughters Fellowship, and choir. She also taught Sunday School for many years.

Lois was predeceased by her brother John Henry in 1959.

She leaves her beloved husband of 71 years, "Dave" Reynolds of Richmond, a son Bruce D. Reynolds of Canaan, a daughter Beth L. Reynolds of West Springfield, MA and a granddaughter Jennifer L. Sitzer of Chatham, NY.
