Mr. Louis F. Bailot, Jr., 90, of Pittsfield, passed away peacefully at his home on Monday, December 18, 2023. Born in Cheshire, MA, on March 27, 1933, the son of the late Louis and Zita Jarvis Bailot, he graduated from Pittsfield High School.

Louis was a Korean War Veteran, a Corporal who served in Germany. He proudly served his country in the United States Army from 1953 until his honorable discharge in 1955.

Louis was a proud Professional Firefighter for the City of Pittsfield for over 30 years until his retirement in 1990. Additionally, Louis was a beloved employee of the Dwyer Funeral Home, where he also worked for over 30 years-- up until his 85th birthday!

Lou loved working in the garage on lawnmowers and snowblowers, he did this for the majority of his life until October 31, 2023.
