Lucy Skok Geer, 100 yrs old of Pittsfield, Ma, died peacefully at home on Thomas Island on Onota Lake on September 1, 2016 shortly after celebrating or 100 th birthday. She was born in Franklin, N.J on August 9, 1916, one of 9 children of John and Julia (Fabri) Skok. She was educated in The Franklin schools and attended business school in Newark, N.J. She moved to Pittsfield with her husband Milton U Geer over 60 years ago after living in New Jersey, Arkansas, Texas and New York State and their children. She worked as an executive secretary in New Jersey and later in Pittsfield after raising her 4 children.
