Mr. Luke J. Ferguson, Jr, 77, of Pittsfield, passed away on Sunday, June 6, 2021, surrounded by his loving family. Born in Sanford, Maine, on April 18, 1944, he was the son of the late Luke and Elaine Tebbetts Ferguson.

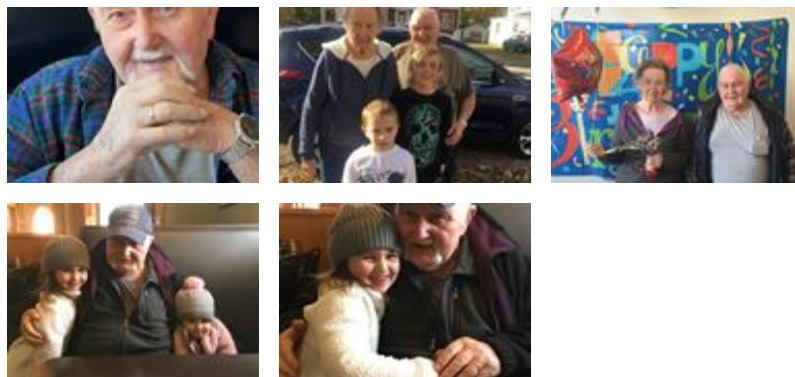
