Mrs. Marilyn C. Harte, 88, formerly of Lee, MA, passed away at her home New York on Wednesday, January 27, 2021, surrounded by her loving family. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on April 20, 1932, the daughter of the late Leonard and Bella Vienneau LeBlanc, she graduated from St. Joseph High School in 1950 and later earned her bachelor's degree.
