



Mrs. Marjorie N. Allen

December 8, 1931 - February 20, 2024

Mrs. Marjorie N. Allen, 92, of Pittsfield, MA passed away peacefully on Tuesday, February 20, 2024. Born in Manchester, New Hampshire, on December 8, 1931, the daughter of the late Andre and Laurette Elliot Nicholson, she graduated from Watertown High School, and later earned her bachelor's degree in Asian Studies from Smith College as an Ada Comstock scholar, graduating in 1989. One of the highlights of her life was spending a month in Japan with a host family as a part of her scholarship at Smith college.

Marjorie was a Unit Coordinator at the Berkshire Medical Center emergency room during the 70's and 80's, but her true passion was for writing. Her published books are as follows: "The Remarkable Ride of Israel Bissel, as Recalled by Molly the Crow", "One, Two, Three Achool!", Farley Are You for Real?" and "Marble Cake Cat" both co-authored with her son Carl, "What Are Little Girls Made Of", "Changes" (which received numerous awards, including the Ezra Keats Award), "100 Years of Children's Books in America: Decade by Decade" as well as "A Look Inside Alzheimers" co-authored with her niece, Susan Dublin, who had early alzheimers and wanted to help people understand the disease more intimately.

Marjorie was an editor for the Berkshire Eagle and did freelance editing for the New York Times. She also created a website to offer free editing to new and

hopeful authors with many helpful links and trade tips.

As a little girl, Marge enjoyed visiting her grandfather who was the lighthouse keeper at Two Lights in Cape Elizabeth, Maine. She would assist him changing the light bulbs and she loved playing at the ocean. As an adult, she spent many summers with her family at her parent's cottage on the Saint Lawrence River. Marjorie enjoyed singing with the Sweet Adelines for over 30 years, as well as acting in many community plays.

Marjorie was married to David Allen, of Watertown, NY, on July 6, 1957 and enjoyed 52 wonderful and happy years together, the last 10 years of which were spent at their seasonal home in Mexico on the Baja peninsula. David passed away in 2009. She was also predeceased by her son John's wife Jill S Allen who passed away in 2015.

She leaves behind sons John Allen of Lanesborough, MA and Carl Allen of Pittsfield, MA as well as a daughter Dena Allen of Pittsfield, MA, and her brother Edward Nicholson, of Ormond Beach, FL.. She also leaves her grandchildren Sean, Meghan, Matthew, and Taylor, as well as 9 great-grandchildren
