Marjorie Price Steele passed peacefully on December 8, 2022 at Mount Carmel Center after a recent heart attack.

Marjorie was born in Pittsfield, MA on July 5, 1933, she was the first daughter of Edward C. and Mildred E. Beaupre Chapman. The family moved to Canaan, NY in 1937 and Marjorie graduated from Chatham (NY) High School in 1951. Awarded a full-tuition scholarship to Miss Herbit's Pittsfield Secretarial School, she graduated top student & remained fully employed as an executive secretary from 1952 through 1994.

Marjorie was a member of the First Congregational Church U.C.C. in Dalton, serving as Historian, Church Council, Woman's Fellowship, the Mission Board (Chairperson), Board of Deacons (Chairperson), the flower Committee (Chairperson) and the Sew n' Such Circle. Marjorie was an active member of the Pittsfield Business and Professional Woman's Organization (President 1986-1988) and was also a member of the Current Topics Club of Dalton (President 1995 1996). A long-time member of Church Woman United executive board, she was given the honor of Valiant Woman in 2004.

Marjorie was predeceased by her second husband Eugene K. Steele in 2005. They were married in 1980. Her first husband Donald E. Price whom she married in 1954 passed away in 1966.

She leaves two sons Jeffrey W. Price (Jacqueline) of Pittsfield, Douglas E. Price of Cold Springs, NY, step-daughter Marlene Doyle (Peter Fruet) of Pittsfield and step-son Gregory Steele (Diane) of Sarasota, FL as well as many grandchildren and great-grandchildren. She also leaves her sister Ginger Leavenworth of Pittsfield, MA and her brother David (Liz) Chapman of Chatham, NY.
