January 3, 1956 - December 6, 2025

Mr. Michael P. Londergan, of Pittsfield, passed away unexpectedly on Saturday, December 6, 2025, just a month shy of celebrating his 70th birthday. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on January 3, 1956, son of the late William and Maureen Brophy Londergan, he graduated Pittsfield High School with the class of 1973.

For the majority of his career, Mike worked as a route driver for various companies, such as Frito Lay, Pepsi, and Cintas. Most recently, in his retirement, he was working as a courier for Berkshire Bank.

Among many things, Mike was a diehard Dallas Cowboys fan, and always rooting for the Boston Red Sox. He enjoyed his bowling league and, in his earlier years, was an avid dart player. Mike always looked forward to his “weekly gathering” with friends, and, for many years, the legendary “Irish Tours” with his cousin, Dave.

From trips to the Cape, Gloucester, and, in recent years, Southern Maine, Mike loved spending time at the ocean with his wife, as it brought him a secure sense of calmness and peace.

Most importantly, he loved being a Dad to his son, Michael, of whom he was extremely proud and loved more than life in itself. Mike’s greatest joy were his

grandchildren, MJ and Mackenize, who were the lights of his life. They brought him more happiness and love than they would ever know, easily making his favorite title that of “Grampa”.

Mike is survived by his beloved wife of 28 years, the former Linda-Lee Sadlowski Londergan, whom he married on May 10, 1997. He leaves behind his son, Michael W. Londergan, Sr. (Stefanie Londergan), as well as his grandchildren, Michael Londergan, Jr., and Mackenzie Londergan, both of whom he adored. Mike also leaves behind his brothers-in-law, Robert Sadlowski (Nadine), and Joel Sadlowski, as well as many nieces, nephews, cousins and friends too numerous to count.

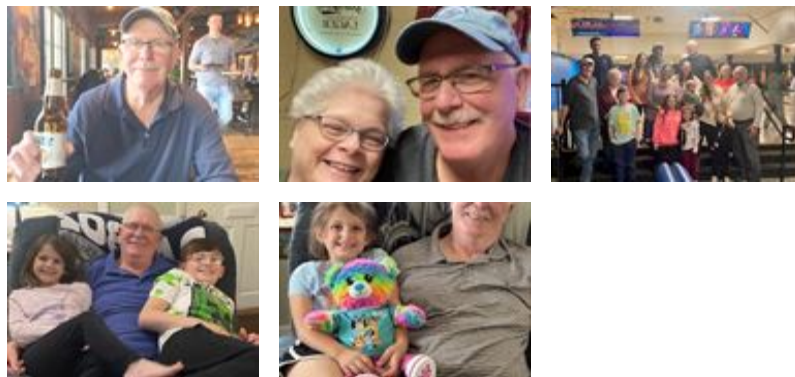
