Mr. Michael J. Quagliano, 73, of 24 Ocean St., Lanesborough, died at home Monday, February 6, 2012 surrounded by his family. Born Providence RI on April 6, 1938 the son of Michael A. and Lillian E. Lessard Quagliano, he attended Pittsfield High School.

Mr. Quaglian was a US Air Force Veteran.
