



## Ms. Nancy Meyers Ferdinand

March 7, 1940 - June 6, 2024

Ms. Nancy Meyers Ferdinand, of Williamstown, passed away on Thursday, June 6, 2024, just months after celebrating her 84th birthday. Born in Washington, DC, on March 7, 1940, the daughter of the late Ernest S. Meyers and Shirley Scheuer Meyers, she was raised in New Rochelle, New York and Scarsdale, New York. She graduated from Scarsdale High School in 1958, and later attended both the University of Miami and Boston University, before leaving for a job in the beauty industry in New York City.

For the majority of her life, Nancy lived in New York City, where she worked as an office manager for medical offices. In 1999, Nancy relocated to Williamstown and built a new life for herself over the past twenty-five years. She worked for more than 15 years in clerical positions at North Adams Hospital and, later, Berkshire Medical Center.

She enjoyed auditing film and history classes at Williams College, and she regularly attended local institutions such as the Clark Art Museum and Williamstown Theater Festival. She was also an avid sports fan and passionately followed her beloved New York Rangers hockey team with great interest every season. Most of all, Nancy enjoyed spending time with her family and their beloved pets, which she referred to as her “grand-doggies.”

Nancy is survived by her son, Jed Ferdinand and daughter in law, Wendy

Ferdinand, of Weston, Connecticut; her granddaughter, Olivia Ferdinand, who will become a student at Harvard Law School in the fall; and her grandson, Tyler Ferdinand, who is a rising senior at the University of Richmond., as well as her beloved brother, Eric Barton Meyers, a lawyer in Miami, Florida, predeceased her in 1990.
