Mr. Nicholas R. French, 45, of Dalton, passed away peacefully at his home on Friday, October 31, 2025, after a valiant battle with cancer. Born in Amsterdam, NY, on May 25, 1980, son of Virginia Hoffman Saltsman and the late Robert Saltsman, he graduated from Fort Plain High School with the class of 1999.

Nicholas began his career at McDonalds, where he worked as the assistant manager from 1997-2015. He then started work at St. Mary's Hospital, where he dedicated 5 years. Nicholas later worked as the manager of Kay Jewelers until 2022, when his illness forced him to resign.

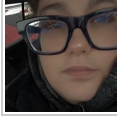
