Mrs. Norma M. Coy, 87, of Pittsfield, passed away Friday afternoon, May 21, 2021, at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Pittsfield on January 7, 1934, the daughter of the late Constanzo and Concetta Furiota Quadrozzi, she attended Pittsfield schools and graduated from Pittsfield High School in 1951.

Mrs. Coy was employed at General Electric as a secretary and then worked as a receptionist at Manuela's Beauty Salon, where she had initially volunteered to "help out a friend for a few months", but stayed for years. She volunteered at Williams School and was also a longtime volunteer for "Walks and Talks" at Tanglewood. Norma was a lifelong resident of Pittsfield and a communicant of Sacred Heart Church.

Mrs. Coy was predeceased by her loving husband of nearly 60 years, Thomas Coy, whom she married on July 4, 1957. Thomas passed away on May 20, 2016, due to complications of Alzheimer's disease. She is survived by her daughter, Paula Feakes and her husband, David; two grandchildren, Hannah Elizabeth Feakes and Sadie Rose Feakes; a sister and brother-in-law, Helen and John Castonguay; sisters-in-law, Betty Loehr and Elizabeth Pregent; a brother-in-law, Joseph Coy; a brother, William Quadrozzi; and many nieces and nephews. 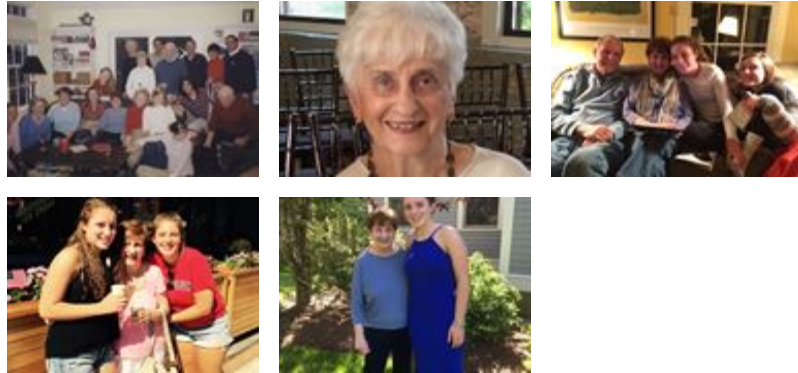
