Mr. Norman J. Brunet, of Pittsfield, passed away at his home on Sunday, June 30, 2024, just weeks after celebrating his 87th birthday. Born in Burlington, VT, on June 8, 1937, he was the son of the late Euclide and Florence Mueller Brunet.

Norman was a member of the United States Army. He enlisted at the age of 21 and proudly served his country from 1958 until his honorable discharge as a Private in 1960.
