



Mr. Oscar "OJ" Rigdon

June 18, 1940 - July 29, 2021

Oscar J (OJ) Rigdon, 81 of Lehigh Acres, Florida passed away on Thursday, July 29, 2021 after a long and courageous battle with cancer. Born on June 18, 1940, to the late Oscar Washington Rigdon and Byrdie Lee Mobley. He was the only son of eight children.

He attended schools in Fort Myers and at the age of 17 enlisted in the Marine Corps. Early in his Marine career he was introduced to the love of his life and future wife, Shirley Ann Griffin. They would have celebrated their 59th wedding anniversary on August 25th. Together they raised their family in the Marine Corps residing on many bases across the United States.

OJ Served 23 years of distinguished service as a Marine, holding positions as a Bus Driver, Master Machinist, Master Instructor and Ordnance Chief. He retired in 1980. During his time in the service, he was deployed globally to Australia, Cape Town South Africa, the Philippines, Taiwan, and Okinawa Japan. OJ served during the Vietnam War.

After retiring, OJ moved his family to Pittsfield where he was employed as a machinist for General Electric and Data Flute. He also worked at England Brothers and Dwyer Funeral Home. OJ enjoyed bowling, fishing, playing the guitar, coaching baseball, softball, and football. He loved mowing his lawn, soft serve ice cream and of course, sweet tea. He considered family time, precious time.

OJ was known for his great faith, never missing an opportunity to share God's word with friends, an acquaintance or even a stranger. He wanted everyone

he met to know they could experience the same love, joy, and peace that he does by knowing Jesus.

OJ is survived by his wife and their children, Virginia (Gini) Marauszwski, Colleen O'Brien (Mark) and Jay Rigdon (Teresa), his sisters Myra Rigdon, Ola Mae Kirkland (Henry), Shirley Rene Carmona and Debra Artile.
