Mr. Paul Koronchik, 91, of Kellie Dr. died Tuesday, October 21, 2014 at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Pittsfield on April 14, 1923 the son of the late Jacob and Anna Roba Koronchik, he was a 1941 graduate of Pittsfield High School.

Mr. Koronchik served in the 34th infantry Division of the US Army from 1942 to 1945. He was stationed in Italy and was present at the battle of Monte Casino Monastery. He earned two combat badges for his front-line service.
