Mr. Peter T. Amuso, 69, of Pittsfield, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, May 15, 2020. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on February 25, 1951, the son of Dorothy Londergan Amuso and the late Joseph A. Amuso, he graduated from Pittsfield High School in 1969. He was a communicant of St. Charles Church. Pete worked as a firefighter for the City of Pittsfield for 34 dedicated years. He proudly served alongside his father, brother, uncles and cousin. He earned the title of Fire Investigator, being certified by the National Board on Fire Service.
