Mr. Raymond T. Russell, 75, of 63 Cromwell Ave., died Thursday, April 21, 2011 at home surrounded by his loving family. Born in Pittsfield on March 14, 1936 the son of Eugene M. and Bertha Card Russell, he was a 1953 graduate of St. Joseph's High School.
