



## Mr. Raymond J. Therrien

February 28, 1922 - September 4, 2015

Mr. Raymond J. Therrien, 93, formerly of Dalton Ave., Pittsfield, passed away on Friday, September 4, 2015 at Mount Greylock Extended Care, with his son by his side. Born in Pittsfield on February 28, 1922 the son of Albert A. and Theresa V. Hooker Therrien, he was a 1940 graduate of Pittsfield High School.

Mr. Therrien was a US Army Air Corps Veteran of WWII. He served as an Aircraft Mechanic and Crew Chief.

He worked for General Electric in Pittsfield for 44 years. He retired in 1984 as a Quality Control Planner in the Ordnance Division.

He was a member of the GE Quarter Century and Pensioners club. He enjoyed bowling and was a member of the Besse-Clarke league at Ken's Bowl. Mr. Therrien also enjoyed playing golf and traveling with his wife Alice. Mr. Therrien was a former communicant of St. Mary the Morning Star Church. He was predeceased by his wife, the former Alice E. Cavanaugh, whom he married on February 3, 1945 in St. Joseph Church. She passed away on December 9, 2008. He is survived by a son, retired Pittsfield Police officer, Paul R. Therrien and his wife Donna of Lanesborough; beloved granddaughter who was the Light of his Life, Morgan A. Therrien also of Lanesborough and many nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by his six siblings.
