Robert Dustin Barry, was born May 3, 1949 in North Adams, MA to Bartholomew and Barbara Lane Barry. He graduated from East Longmeadow High School, then the University of Vermont, where he majored in political science and met the love of his life, Mary Theresa McLaughlin.

While attending UVM, Bob “Raz” enlisted in the Vermont National Guard, serving 6 years as a medic. Bob and Mary couldn’t wait to start a loving family of their own. They married in July of 1972 and soon after welcomed their first of five children, Colleen, into their family. They spent their first four years together in Burlington, Vermont welcoming their second child, Brennan.
