Mr. Robert T. Bordeau, 60, of 25 Winesap Rd., died suddenly on Wednesday evening, August 29, 2012. Born in Pittsfield on April 15, 1952 the son of the late George Bordeau and Amelia DiNicola Bordeau, he was a 1970 graduate of St. Joseph's High School, where he was a quarterback of the football team. Mr. Bordeau was currently working as a Correction Officer for the Berkshire County Sheriff's Department where he had been employed for the last twelve years. Previously, he worked for General Electric in Pittsfield and was employed at the former Beloit Jones for twenty seven years, until its closing in 1999.

Bob had a true zest for life and was known for his sense of humor. He was a great outdoorsman, enjoying hunting, snowmobiling, and relaxing by the pool. He loved playing golf.

He was a member of the GEAA, Berkshire Nautilus Health Club and Berkshire West Athletic Club. Bob enjoyed watching sports and was an avid New York Yankees and New York Giants fan.
