Robert Eugene Whitney, 79, of Pittsfield passed away Sunday, June 18, 2017. Born July 4, 1937 in Indianapolis, IN, the son of Dorothea J. and Robert W. Whitney. Bob grew up in Muncie, IN and graduated from Muncie Central High where he participated in swimming, track, and cross-country.

Upon graduation, he served in the Navy for 3 years' active duty, including a year on the USS Fulton AS-11.

Following his service, he graduated from The John Herron Institute with a BA in Advertising Art. In 1962, he joined GE Advertising and Sales Promotion Operations. His career included assignments in Schenectady, Chicago, San Jose, Selkirk, and ultimately Pittsfield. He retired from GE Plastics Marketing Communications in 1997.

Bob was an artisan with a lifelong hobby of model ship building, wood working, and wooden boat construction. He enjoyed archery and skeet shooting. He appreciated a diverse range of music and literature. Bob deeply cherished close relationships with his extended family and friends.

Bob is survived by Susan, his wife of 42 years. He also leaves his 3 children, R.
