Ronald (Ron) Joseph Boody, Sr., 76, of Pittsfield, passed away unexpectedly at Berkshire Medical Center on Monday, March 15, 2021. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on January 26, 1945, the son of the late Raymond and Dorothy Harriman Boody.

Ron attended Pittsfield Schools. He was a former member of Christian Assembly church where he served on the Church Board as a Trustee for many years and enjoyed driving the church van.
