Mr. Ronald A. Morton, 76, of Pittsfield, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 20, 2017 at Springside Rehabilitation and Skilled Care Center. Born in Shelburne Falls on October 8, 1940 the son of Austin Morton and Delia Billiel, he was a 1958 graduate of Shelburne Falls Arms Academy.

Mr. Morton moved to Pittsfield in 1959 where he worked for St. Luke's Hospital from 1961 until 1967 and later Pittsfield General Hospital. He retired in 2001 from Berkshire Medical Center as a Darkroom Technician after spending 40 years in the Radiology field.

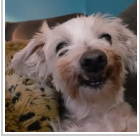

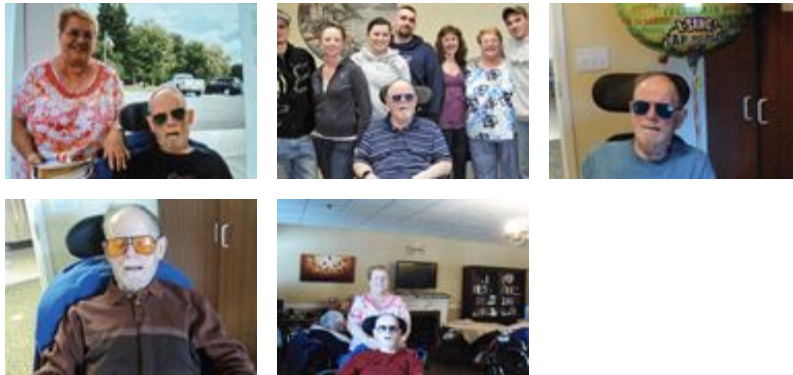
