



## Mr. Ronald "Ron" Sabin

February 8, 1961 - November 18, 2024

Mr. Ronald "Ron" Sabin, 63, of Hancock, passed away on Monday, November 18, 2024. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on February 8, 1961, son of the late Richard and Mary Arthur Sabin, he graduated from Taconic High School.

Ron was employed by Stop and Shop, where he worked as the manager of their grocery department. It was there he dedicated 44 years, until his retirement in 2021.

Among many things, he enjoyed coaching Pittsfield Minor League Baseball, which he did in his younger years. He was fond of NASCAR racing, and loved boating, especially on Onota and Pontoosuc Lakes. Additionally, Ron was a diehard fan of the Dallas Cowboys.

Ronald is survived by his beloved wife, the former Maureen Magner, with whom, on November 20th, he would have celebrated his one year wedding anniversary. 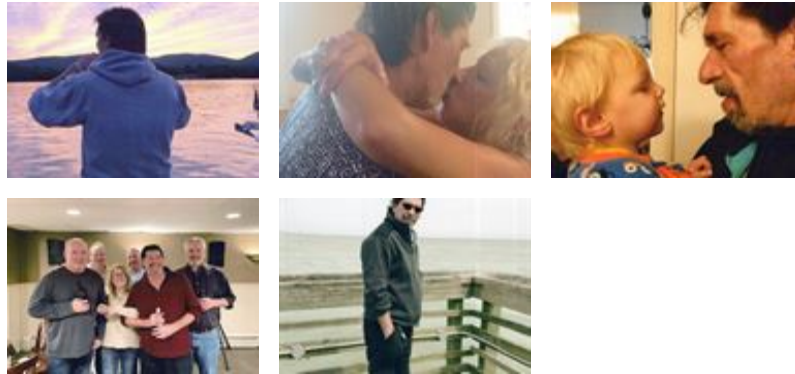
