Sara "Sally" Stevens, 80, of Pittsfield, passed away on Monday, April 25, 2022. Born in Schenectady, NY, on October 15, 1941, she was the daughter of the late William and Mildred Kellogg Haley, she graduated from the Vincentian Institute in Albany NY and St. Mary's Hospital School of Nursing in Amsterdam, NY.

Sara was most recently employed by the Visiting Nurses of Berkshire County where she worked as a registered nurse. It was there she dedicated 21 years until her retirement.
