Scott Sturtevant, 59, passed away February 2, 2016 after a brave fight with leukemia.

Scott was born on June 25, 1956 in Windsor, MA, where he resided proudly for his entire life. He was the son of Barbara and the late George Sturtevant. He graduated from Wahconah Regional in 1974. He has been a volunteer firefighter for the town for 43 years, most recently serving as the Assistant Chief. He was also active in coaching sports when his children were younger, was president of the Wahconah Football Booster Club and treasured his role acting as cheerleader for his grandson. In addition to being a toolmaker at Modern, Mold, and Tool, Inc. for 33 years, he owned and operated Itty Bitty Farm, Trust with his family. His passions included fantasy football, classic cars, snowmobiling, corny jokes, and being a family man.

Scott is survived by his wife, Darlene, and his children: Andrea McDonough (husband Michael); Jacquelyn Bell (husband Jason); Daniel Sturtevant (wife Valerie); Christine Robie; his grandsons Ryan McDonough and Joseph Puia. He also leaves behind his siblings Charles, Nicholas, Cathy, and Tina, as well as many nieces and nephews and several other loved ones.
