Mr. Shawn R. Ouillette, 62, of Pittsfield, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, April 28, 2025. Born in Caribou, Maine on November 6, 1962, son of the late Richard and Theresa Marquis Ouillette, he graduated as salutatorian from Caribou High School with the class of 1981. Shawn continued his education at The University of Maine in Orono where he earned his bachelor's degree in Management.

He started his managerial career with Ames Department Stores, relocating him to Berkshire County. Shawn was employed by Excelsior Integrated for over 31 years, where he recently became CEO.

Among many things, Shawn enjoyed spending time outdoors hunting, fishing, and skiing. He was a lifelong Boston Red Sox and New England Patriots fan. 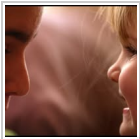
