



Mr. Stanley J. "Pete" Snyder

November 6, 1930 - July 26, 2012

Mr. Stanley J. "Pete" Snyder, 81, of 166 Dalton Division Rd., Pittsfield, died Thursday, July 26, 2012 at Berkshire Medical Center after a brief illness. Born in Pittsfield on November 6, 1930 the son of Stanley and Alice Dydowicz Snyder, he was a 1948 graduate of Pittsfield High School and also attended Westfield State College.

Mr. Snyder taught for the Pittsfield Public Schools vocational Program at Taconic High School in the Print Shop for over thirty years. He had also formerly worked for Eagle Printing and Binding.

He was a Korean War Veteran, serving in the US Coast Guard.

Pete was an avid bowler and was active in the Junior Bowling league as well as bowling in the men's league at Ken's Bowl. A Junior Bowling League award has been named in his honor. He wrote a bowling column in the Berkshire Eagle, Ten Pin Highlights, as well as reporting basketball highlights in the Eagle for Wahconah High School. He was also a Baseball umpire at both the high school and college levels.

Mr. Snyder enjoyed golf and was a member of the Berkshire Hills Country Club for many years and had played in golf leagues. He was a former member of the Stanley Club and a communicant of the former St. Francis Xavier Church.

He leaves his wife, the former Regina Garrity, whom he married on July 9, 1955; a son, Peter J. Snyder and his wife Sue, of Morrison, CO and a sister, Rachel Majchrowski and her husband Ed, of Pittsfield.
