Ms. Susan J. Busener, of Lanesborough, passed away at her home on Sunday, September 24, 2023, just weeks before celebrating her 66th birthday. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on October 15, 1957, the daughter of Lois M. Dearstyne and the late Edwin R. Sprague, she graduated from Wahconah High School with the class of 1975.

Since 1989, Sue has committed her life to recovering addicts, opening doors for hundreds who have sought a new way of life. In 2006, Sue started her career with the Brien Center. While she began as per diem for the Direct Care at the Keenan House, she later moved to a full-time role for their Supportive Housing department, where she remained for 10 years. In March of 2013, Sue became licensed as a Licensed Alcohol and Drug Counselor II. She left the agency in 2017 when she moved out of state, but was soon to return as Site Supervisor at Peck's Road, where she, in 2020, supervised a team that supports eight individuals.

Among many things, she enjoyed, family, friends, her dogs, and her passion to help people through their journey.

She is survived by her mother, Lois M Dearstyne, as well as her siblings, Michael J. Sprague of North Port, FL, Melissa J. Sumner, Lisa J. Sprague, and Russell J. Sprague of Pittsfield, MA. She leaves behind her aunt and

uncle, Melody and David Lincoln, her nieces, Tonya, Shawna, Nicola, Sahsha, Jamie, Lyndsey, Shamyra, Alicia, Natasha, and her nephews, Kevin, Austin, Mathew, Jared, Steffon, Raheem, Michael, Brandon, and Bronson. Susan also leaves behind many dear great nieces and great nephews along with her friend and former husband, Frank Busener.

Sue was predeceased by her father, Edwin R. Sprague, as well as her siblings, Michele J. Fowlkes and Matthew J. Sprague.
