



Mr. Thomas F. Condrón

June 18, 1935 - March 12, 2022

Mr. Thomas F. Condrón, 86, formerly of Pittsfield, passed away in Canaan, CT, on Saturday, March 12, 2022. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on June 18, 1935, the son of the late John and Emily Watkins Condrón, he graduated from the former Dalton High School and later earned his Master's degree from the University of Massachusetts.

Tom was Assistant Principal and Principal at Hoosic Valley High School (in his spare time, that is, since his favorite thing to do most was golfing). He was a member of Wahconah Country Club for over 50 years, played all the courses in Berkshire County, and almost all in the surrounding New England states. He spent most winters playing golf in Myrtle Beach and adjusting the weight of his three-wood.

Tom was predeceased by his beloved wife and golf partner for 58 years, the former Claudia Pitts, whom he married June 18, 1960. Claudia passed away on January 3, 2019. He is survived by his daughter, Kelly Criswell, as well as his two dear grandchildren, Ben (Wahconah Member Guest partner 2011) and Alison Criswell.
