She boarded the General C. H. Muir with her mother escaping

the ravages of World War II from port in Bremerhaven, Lower Saxony, Germany and emigrated to the United States through Ellis Island, New York shortly after her ninth birthday arriving in America on February sixteenth 1951, ultimately becoming a naturalized citizen. She attended private schools in Greenwich, CT before moving to Springfield Massachusetts where she raised her family.

She participated actively in the Springfield education system. At Chestnut Junior High, and other Title One locations, she tutored children learning English as a second language, a challenge she was personally familiar with, as English was her not her native tongue when she arrived in this country. She also ran for a seat on the Springfield school committee in the 1980's.

She was an accomplished seamstress through of her adult life, and was known for making beautiful apparel for all of her

children. She also used her seamstress and sewing skills she had learned from her mother at Carters making baby clothes, and had also been employed at an upholstery shop among many other stores and shops that made use of these skills over the years. She also worked at Smith and Wesson through a temporary company as a machine operator.

When she retired to Pittsfield she used her creative abilities and talents to enrich the community with her arts and crafts and ceramics business.
