treasures with other gardeners. She also loved cooking, making both new and traditional recipes, and was known to drop by friends and family with a jar of soup, or if she really liked you, her famous rice pudding. She also loved to bake Pizzelles.

Recently, her most beloved pastime was spending time with her two grandchildren, cheering on Carter when he was bowling or playing Little League Baseball, or playing with Lilian.
