



Ms. Virginia Colton Larkin

October 27, 1931 - August 6, 2024

Ms. Virginia Colton Larkin, 92, formerly of Richmond, MA, passed away on Tuesday, August 6, 2024. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on October 27, 1931, daughter of the late Dean and Ruth Doughty Colton, she graduated from Pittsfield High School with the class of 1949.

For the majority of her career, Virginia was employed by Crane and Company, where she worked in both their clerical and design departments. It was there she dedicated 47 years until her retirement in 1996.

Among many things, Virginia enjoyed collecting stamps, coins, and postcards. She was a member of the Richmond Historical Society and her home in Richmond was the original one-room North Schoolhouse. She was also an active member of the Berkshire County Historical Society, the First Church of Pittsfield and the Eastern Star. Additionally, Virginia was an Airplane Spotter during World War II.

She is survived by her nephew, Stuart Dixon (Nancy), as well as many dear grandnieces and grandnephews.

Besides her parents, she was predeceased by her siblings, Barbara Colton Dixon and Janet Colton Sugden.
